The SOE® survey is offered to more than 300 APG members in 43 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. This year, 122 medical groups, health systems, and independent practice associations (IPAs) participated in the voluntary survey, covering 12.9 million commercial lives, 3.2 million Medicare Advantage lives, and 3.7 million Medicaid lives.

"I'm very proud of our members for their continued success on SOE®, specifically how they repeatedly prove that risk-based, coordinated care is the best care model for the patients and communities they serve," said Amy Nguyen Howell, MD, APG's Chief Medical Officer. "Seeing so many of our members receive the highly coveted Elite status confirms what we know—physician groups across the country are leaders in the ongoing value movement."

2018 Survey Highlights:

- Eighty-seven physician organizations achieved the coveted Elite honor in 2018. The same number of Elite honors were achieved in 2017.
- Seventy-one percent of SOE® participants made Elite designation. This is an increase of almost 10 percentage points when compared to last year's survey.
- Six new organizations achieved Elite status, with 11 new groups participating in 2018.
