History

From our formation as the Physician Groups Council in 1995, to the California Association of Physician Organizations (CAPO) in 2002, to the California Association of Physician Groups (CAPG) in 2003, to CAPG, the Voice of Accountable Physician Groups in 2013, our organization has been the leading association representing accountable, coordinated physician groups. And while our roots are in California, we rebranded to America's Physician Groups (APG) in 2018 to better reflect our vast national presence.

While our name has changed over the years, our mission remains the same — delivering comprehensive, coordinated care to keep the population healthy while working within a defined budget. Our members are accountable for both cost and quality.
